



About the Conference

The Director and the Academic Staff of Master in Law & Economics organize the International Conference "**International Economic Organisations and Migration Policy**", which will take place virtually on the 29th of June 2021 from 16.00 to 21.00 CET.

Migration and mobility, as well as related issues such as inclusion, remain high on global policy agendas. Recent political shifts have both contributed to and been impacted by intensifying negative public attitudes towards minorities, particularly migrants and asylum-seekers. Meanwhile, the COVID-19 pandemic and responses to it such as lockdowns and the introduction of border controls have brought mobility and immobility into sharp relief, while international attention to racism and its impacts has both demanded attention to different forms of injustice and reinvigorated discussions about how to address them.

The Inspiration Behind

Refugee Empowerment & Work Integration Programme (REWIP): REWIP is an EU-funded project aiming at supporting young migrants, refugees and asylum seekers (aged 18 – 30) that arrive in a new country of residence in the EU and wish to make their first steps towards achieving work integration and as an extension, social integration.

Call for Papers

The conference aims to bring together leading academics, researchers, and junior scholars to share their experiences and research results on the role of the International Economic Organisations and the European Migration Policy in social inclusion and employability. The Conference will provide an interdisciplinary forum for researchers, practitioners and educators.

The conference will be conducted in Greek and English.

Instructions for Authors

Authors of accepted abstracts are invited to submit full papers through mle@unipi.gr until 18 June 2021 and not later than 25th June 2021.

Publication

Each paper will go through a reviewing process by the Scientific Committee.

Each paper should include:

Title

Full author name(s)

Affiliation(s)

Corresponding author's email address

Abstract

Papers must have the main text prefaced by an abstract of no more than 250-300 words summarising the main arguments and conclusions of the article.

A list of up to five key words may be placed below the abstract.

Main Text

- Texts should not exceed 5000 words plus bibliographic references, in Times New Roman font size 12 and no spaces between the lines. Please use the Harvard reference style.
- A clear introduction section should be given that allows non-specialists in the subject an understanding of the publication and a background of the issue(s) involved.
- Up to three level headings may be present and must be clearly identifiable using different font sizes, bold or italics. We suggest using Headings 1, 2 and 3 in MS-Word's 'Style' section.
- The texts may include tables, diagrams, images and other similar material. Titles and sources should be mentioned in Times New Roman font size 10.

Acknowledgements (optional)

Any acknowledgements must be headed and in a separate paragraph, placed after the main text but before the reference list.
